**1. DRILL WILL BE ON SUBASE AND CARDINAL HONDA ON ROUTE 12 IN GROTON.** We are not yet able to do hold a car wash due to their construction, but there is community service that we will do. **2.** All hands should have eaten breakfast prior to arriving. Please bring \$5 for lunch, or you may bring your lunch.

**3.** All hands should have ready to turn in upon arrival enrollment payments (contact me privately if you need more time with this), annual medical forms if your last physical is over a year old – it must be on the NSCC form, report cards, Request for Training forms for any advanced trainings, etc.

**4.** COVID-19 Notes: CADETS MUST HAVE AND WEAR THE MASK WE ISSUED unless you wear a special one for medical reasons in which case, we must have a doctor's note on file.

CADETS MUST SUBMIT TO A TEMPERATURE CHECK UPON ARRIVAL, PARENTS NEED TO SIGN TWO FORMS RELATING TO COVID-19.

All Cadets must bring canteen (or water bottle as a last resort).

**5.** Come prepared for drill – plan appropriately so that you are not out of uniform when it comes to uniform parts: canteen w/belt, jewelry (such as earrings) and hair color, nail polish, etc. Dress for the weather.
