3. There are quite a few who need to re-enroll this drill. See the website under Command Notes. It was also posted on Facebook. Cost for cadets is \$91 in cash or check (made payable to USNSCC).
4. All Cadets must bring canteen (or water bottle as a last resort).
5. Come prepared for drill – plan appropriately so that you are not out of uniform when it comes to uniform parts: canteen/ belt, jewelry (such as earrings) and hair color, etc.

7. RT at Ft. Devens is posted – if you wanted to staff or are going as a recruit, let LCDR Jergensen/ENS Hyland know ASAP. All paperwork and the money order for \$300 is due as soon as possible. Deadline to register is June 30<sup>th</sup> or when all quotas are filled which are first come first served.
