4. **Come prepared for drill** – Cadets should bring PT uniform. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
Complete uniform (which includes: haircut/hair style per Nautilus (SSN-571) Division SOP; clean & shined shoes/boots; canteens; appropriate outer- and undergarments; jewelry & make-up per regulations).
5. \$35 for First Aid/CPR/AED certification. Instruction is for All Hands except Indoc that are not current (or licensed beyond this level-documentation MUST be provided). Class is Free but certification will cost \$35 per person.
