Uniform Policy

Naval Sea and Navy League Cadet Corps personnel are authorized to wear certain U.S. Navy uniforms as designated in the U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Uniform Manual found on <http://homeport.seacadets.org>.

There is a cost for uniforms. Nautilus (SSN-571) Division charges a flat rental fee upon enrollment. Uniforms issued by the division remain the property of the division and must be returned upon discharge from the program or when requested. Should a cadet outgrow or need another uniform/accessory for any reason, older ones will be returned for exchange at no extra cost. If an item is not returned, the uniform fee for that item will be charged. Uniforms will be returned in serviceable condition, normal wear and tear accepted. There will be a charge for uniforms that are lost or damaged due to negligence. Due to the sizes available to us by the Navy, we may not be able to provide uniforms for overly large or extremely small cadets. These items would have to be purchased on your own. The rental fee would not be charged for any item the division does not issue and while we would accept the donation of any uniform item that is purchased elsewhere, it is not required to return it when the cadet is discharged from the program. The uniform fee is not refundable.

The current uniform fee for Navy League Cadets is subject to whether or not we can supply the cadet in the Navy NWU. Currently, Navy League Cadets must buy their own Winter Dress Uniform (Dress Blues) and Summer Dress Uniform (Salt & Peppers) due to the fact that we may not be able to provide uniforms in the sizes required.

The uniform fee can be paid in three installments if necessary.

Cadets must provide their own White and/or Blue T-shirts, Socks, Boots and Dress Shoes. Please let the Supply Officer which items you are purchasing on your own and you will not be charged the rental fee for those items.
