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**NOTES**

1. All hands should have the following ready to submit when checking in to drill:
  - \$20 (\$5 per meal) CASH for meals. We cannot accept bills larger than \$20.

  - Cell phones and other electronic devices
  - Medications: Pre-dispensed by parents/guardians in a labeled container and turned in during check-in.
  - Completed Course Assignments/Completed paperwork for Winter training.
  - Money for Re-enrollments/Uniform Rental fees.
2. Refer to the website command notes and previous email from the CO to see who needs to re-enroll this drill. Cost for re enrollment is \$91. Cash is acceptable. Checks should be made payable to USNSCC.
3. **Come prepared for drill** – Cadets should bring: PT uniform. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Cadets should be in complete uniform when they come to drill. Complete uniform includes: **PROPER HAIRCUT, CLEAN/SHINED SHOES/BOOTS.** Wear your uniforms properly. Bring your canteens as it is a part of uniform.
